

The PhD Project Hall of Fame Nomination Form

The PhD Project Hall of Fame nominations will be accepted each year from December 1 to April 30th.

New inductees will be selected by members of the Hall of Fame committee (below) and will be announced and recognized at the PhD Project DSA summer and winter conferences.

Nomination Criteria

To be considered for induction into The PhD Project Hall of Fame, an individual must have:

- Demonstrated sustained involvement with The Project over a 10-year period. **In what ways has the nominee served as an ambassador for The Project, communicating our mission within academe and/or corporate America?** Provide examples of how the nominee has impacted the recruitment and development of The PhD Project student and/or faculty members. i.e., endorsement of The PhD Project mission during speaking engagements/webinars.
- Commitment to The PhD Project is evidenced by involvement with our student and faculty members, participation on task forces and planning committees, recruitment activities, creating enhanced awareness of The PhD Project within an individual's own organization, or other involvement and action to further the mission of The PhD Project. **What significant contributions has the nominee made that have impacted The PhD Project's success?** Outline contributions made by the nominee that have led to the success of The PhD Project (cite examples, i.e., conference/doctoral student association leadership, recruitment activities, mentoring, research collaboration).
- An excellent reputation within the academic, corporate or not for profit community and a source of inspiration and encouragement for others to follow. How has the nominee served as an ambassador for The PhD Project outside of his/her organization? **Nominations require completed nomination form, 3 letters of recommendation which should be limited to one page in addition to the nominator's one-page letter and the nominee CV.**

Selection Process

Nominations will be screened by the Hall of Fame selection committee to ensure that nominees meet the above stated criteria for review/rating to select up to 3 individuals to be inducted into The PhD Project Hall of Fame.

Committee Members include:

- One past president from each DSA – 1 yr. term
- One Faculty advisor from each DSA – 2 yr. term
- One Sponsor representative – 2 yr. term
- Two current Hall of Fame members – 3 yr. term
